General information

Benefit year

• January - December

Termination age

- Health & Dental retirement
- Travel age 70




Prescription drugs

Drug coverage

- 100% pay direct
- \$5 dispensing fee maximum
- Generic pricing
- Special authorization drugs
- Drug lookup on member services site



- 100% coverage
 - Foot orthotics
 - 1 pair per person maximum \$500 every benefit year
 - Requires Biomechanical Assessment & Fabrication Form and written order of physician or nurse practitioner



- 100% coverage
 - Eye examinations
 - 1 per person every 24 months
 - Participants under 19 and over 64 not included, eye exams covered under provincial health care



- Attending Physician's statement
 - \$150 per statement for Short Term Disability form completion



- Sleep apnea devices
 - Physician's or Nurse Practitioner's written order
 - Apnea-Hypopnea Index 15+
 - Breathing monitor (CPAP)
 - 1 breathing monitor every 36 months
 - Accessories included
 - Dental apnea appliance (silencer)
 - 1 dental apnea appliance every 36 months
 - Prescribing physician cannot be dentist



- Sleep apnea devices: purchasing
 - You must have a Doctor or Nurse Practitioner's written order and a sleepy study with an index of 15 or greater
 - Items must be purchased from an eligible provider
 check the delisted provider list in Member
 Services to ensure your provider is eligible
 - Reasonable and customary amounts for breathing monitors are up to \$2500
 - Claims can be made through the member site, members pay for the items and submit online




Paramedical coverage - physiotherapy

• \$1000 per Participant each Benefit Year



Paramedical coverage

- \$1000 per Participant each Benefit Year for Physiotherapist
- \$500 per Participant per practitioner for each Benefit Year
 - Acupuncturist
 - Chiropractor
 - Massage Therapist (physician written order required – helps manage plan costs)
 - Naturopath
 - Osteopath
 - Podiatrist/Chiropodist
 - Speech Language Pathologist



Paramedical coverage – mental health

- \$1000 per Participant each Benefit Year for all of the following practitioners combined
 - Psychologist
 - Master of Social Work
 - Registered Social Worker
- Includes iCBT interactive cognitive behavioral therapy



Cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT)


- CBT is the most effective and commonly used psychotherapy for a wide range of mental health concerns.
- CBT focuses on changing negative thoughts, emotions and attitudes into actionable ways to deal with emotional issues.



iCBT: CBT through a digital platform

iCBT is an internet-based CBT program,
delivered through a robust digital platform,
accessible from any device – smartphone,
tablet, computer – with ongoing guidance
from a therapist





Who is iCBT for?

People experiencing symptoms of:

- Anxiety
- Depression or low mood
- PTSD
- Insomnia
- Trauma
- Panic
- Chronic Pain
- Grief and loss
- Alcohol Use
- Obsessive compulsive disorder (OCD)

Get the same clinical benefits of in-person therapy with iCBT

Is a convenient way to get support from home – access through the iCBT app, using a smartphone or tablet, or on your computer through the web version

SUPPORTED BY PROFESSIONAL THERAPISTS

All iCBT therapists are regulated health professionals



CONVENIENT



Self-directed and self-paced program where progress is saved as you move through the modules that can be accessed from anywhere





Travel benefits


- 90 Days coverage
- Coverage for travel outside province of residence (in and out of Canada)
- \$5,000,000 per person per incident



Vision

Vision benefits


- \$400 per person
 - Adults every 24 months
 - Children under 14 years every 12 months
- Glasses, contact lenses, prescription sunglasses, laser eye surgery



Dental benefits

Basic dental benefits


- 100% up to provincial fee guide
- \$1750 per person, per benefit year combined with extensive benefits
- Examinations, scaling, X-rays, fluoride, fillings, root canals, extractions
- Check dental fee guides and make sure you don't overpay



Dental benefits

Extensive dental benefits

- 80% up to provincial fee guide
- \$1750 per person, per benefit year combined with basic benefits
- Crowns, bridges, implants, dentures procedures with a lab component
- Pre-determination amount: \$800



Dental benefits

Orthodontic dental benefits

- 50%
- \$2500 per person per lifetime
- Under age of 20
- Treatment plan required



Adding individual benefits

- Looking to top up coverage for certain services?
- Can purchase individual benefit plans
- Keep in mind:
 - Cannot purchase dental only
 - Must be on the plan for 2 years before benefits like orthodontia are available
 - Costs can vary an individual dental plan for two adults in their 40s and 2 children under 12 can range from \$284/ month to \$407/ month




With our mobile app and website, your employees can access benefit information and resources at anytime.

Retirement

City of Calgary Retiree plan

- Available to retirees under age 65 who are receiving a pension
- Terminates at age 65
- Prescription drug, health, dental, and travel benefits
- Benefit summaries available from the City of Calgary



Retirement

Alberta Blue Cross individual retiree plan

- Can apply for coverage starting at age 50 when coming off an employer group plan
 - plan or City of Calgary Retiree plan or any other group plan
- No termination age
- Coverage is flexible
 - Can choose benefit levels to fit coverage needs
