Terms of Reference

FDC Threads - Glen Baxter

- Discrepancy between new builds FDC threads (BCT) and the AMA hose threads currently used by CFD
- Failure is oversize female swivel on FDC due to the connection being built to the BCT standard
- Committee performed destructive testing in multiple scenarios (As much volume and pressure as they could) and were not able to produce a failure.
- Determined risk extremely low.
- Going forward AMA/BCST threads will be on every appliance going forward.
- City and FD looking at 3rd party independent engineering sign off
- Provincially City of Calgary and CFD are the only ones pursuing it
- Monthly drill and or safety matters bulletin to be put out, potential Q2/Q3 standpipe training at training tower
- Ongoing until safety matters bulletin is out and there is an update from Glen

Calgary 911 - Hold back

 There has been an identified need for clarity between a ERE and a hold back; hold back a historical term used by CPS and AHS causing confusion with Calgary 911

- Calgary 911 working on improving this by building a TOR among all stakeholders, access to real time data, Calgary 911 to co-evaluate calls and more accurate mapping data
- ADC Mcasey has been connected with review specialist for AHS dispatch so issues can be communicated directly.

Station #14 Reno/Living Conditions

- Per ADC Forbes, crews will be moved into 14 station by the end of January.

Facepiece Inspections

- Face piece individually tracked because they are part of the respiratory protection package.
